The health and safety of every individual at Newport News Shipbuilding is our top priority. I am writing you today to ensure that you are aware of current COVID-19 protocols at our facility. The following requirements apply to all individuals, including subcontractors and suppliers, while on company property.

- Masks are mandatory. All individuals are required to wear a mask or cloth face covering
 if they are within 6 feet of anyone, and while in transit. This requirement follows Centers for
 Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance that masks and face coverings are proven to
 stop the spread of COVID-19. Read our NNS mask guidance fact sheet for more information.
- Failure to wear a mask or cloth face covering at NNS could result in refused entry and/or badge deactivation.
- Maintain a social distance of 6 feet or more between yourself and others.
- Report any confirmed cases of COVID-19 to NNS by calling 1-844-243-8749.

As of July 3, NNS discontinued temperature screenings. However, individuals should continue daily self-monitoring and stay at home/contact their doctor if their temperature is 100°F (38°C) or higher.

It is critical that you comply with these safety measures to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.
